## Crown + Bridge, Crowns, Inlays, or Onlays

If you received a crown + bridge, crowns, inlays, or onlays in our office recently, here are a few things to be aware of.

  - You will wear temporary restorations until your permanent restoration is made.
- If your temporary falls off or breaks, save the pieces and call our office.
- Do not bite your lips and/or cheeks or scrape your gums. Children should be watched carefully to make sure they don't do this. It will damage soft tissues and result in pain.
- Sensitivity to cold and heat, as well as any soreness, should go away in a few days.
- Brush and floss carefully for the first few days.
